Seek unity

- Christ is not divided
- Baptism does not save
- The message of Christ's death is what saves
- The skill of the messenger does not save
- The message of the cross sounds fool, but it is the wisdom of God
- The wisdom of the world does not save

Consider the wisdom of God

- See how He operates in His creation (1 Cor 1:26-29)




Jeremiah 9:23-24

- Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise *man* glory in his wisdom, Let not the mighty *man* glory in his might, Nor let the rich *man* glory in his riches; But let him who glories glory in this, **That he understands and knows Me, That I *am* the LORD, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight," says the LORD.**

Consider the wisdom of God

- See how He operates in His creation (1 Cor 1:26-29)
- See what He is able to provide through weak and foolish actions—according to human standards (1 Cor 1:30-31)
- See the manner in which the message of the cross is presented (1 Cor 2:1-5)

Acts 18:9-10

- Now the Lord spoke to Paul in the night by a vision, "**Do not be afraid**, but speak, and do not keep silent; for I am with you, and **no one will attack you to hurt you**; for I have many people in this city."
