

The Riches of God's Grace

Ephesians 1:7-14

Isaiah 59:2

- But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden *His* face from you, So that He will not hear.

Spurgeon said...

- The Epistle to the Ephesians is a complete Body of Divinity. In the first chapter you have the doctrines of the gospel; in the next, you have the experience of the Christians; and before the Epistle is finished, you have the precepts of the Christian faith. Whosoever would see Christianity in on treatise, let him "read, mark, learn, and inwardly digest" the Epistle to the Ephesians.

Admire the riches of God's Grace

- God's grace forgives sin (Eph 1:7)

Matthew 10:42-45

- But Jesus called them to *Himself* and said to them, "You know that those who are considered rulers over the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant. And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Admire the riches of God's Grace

- God's grace forgives sin (Eph 1:7)
- God's grace gives you Jesus Christ, God's greatest treasure (Eph 1:8-12)
- God's grace gives you a proof of the certainty of God's promises (Eph 1:13-14)

John 16:7, 13-14

- "Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.
- "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare *it* to you.
