 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

The leading of the Spirit...

- Keeps you from carrying out the works of the flesh (Gal 5:19-21)

- Effectively crucifies the fleshly, sinful desires (enabling Christ to live in you and pursue the will of the Father; Gal 5:24)
- Stops you from becoming self-centered—upset with others for what they have and upsetting others in your discontent (Gal 5:25-26)
