# Psalm 118:25-26

- **Save now**, I pray, O LORD; O LORD, I pray, send now prosperity. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the LORD! We have blessed you from the house of the LORD.



# Zechariah 9:9

- " **Rejoice greatly**, O daughter of Zion!  
Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem!  
Behold, your King is coming to you;  
He *is* just and having salvation,  
Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt,  
the foal of a donkey.

# Daniel 7:13

- " I was watching in the night visions,  
And behold, *One like the Son of Man*,  
Coming with the clouds of heaven!  
He came to the Ancient of Days, And  
they brought Him near before Him.

# Daniel 7:14

- "Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion *is an everlasting dominion, Which shall not pass away, And His kingdom the one Which shall not be destroyed*



# Isaiah 53:10

- Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put *Him* to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see *His seed*, He shall prolong *His days*, And *the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.*





# Isaiah 53:11

- He shall see **the labor of His soul,** *and* be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant **shall justify many,** For He shall **bear their iniquities.**



# Matthew 10:37-39

- "He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. He who finds his life will lose it, and **he who loses his life for My sake will find it.**



# Luke 9:23-24

- Then He said to *them* all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but **whoever loses his life for My sake will save it.**

# John 5:44

- "How can you believe, who receive honor from one another, and do not seek the honor that *comes* from the only God?"



# Matthew 26:39, 42

- He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, "O My Father, **if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me**; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You *will*."
- Again, a second time, He went away and prayed, saying, "O My Father, if this cup cannot pass away from Me **unless I drink it**, Your will be done."

# Understand the Victorious King

- He is the one the prophecies talked about (John 12:12-19)
- Only through death He achieves victory (John 12:20-30)
- His victory is the end of the power of the Devil (John 12:31-33)



# Hebrews 2:14-15

- Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.



# Philippians 1:21

- For to me, to live *is* Christ, and to die *is* gain.
