John 16:25-33

John 16:12-14

- "I still have **many things** to say to you, but **you cannot bear *them now***. However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, **He will guide you into all truth**; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare *it* to you.

Luke 24:25-27

- Then He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?" And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, **He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.**

Luke 24:44-45

- Then He said to them, "These *are* the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and *the* Prophets and *the* Psalms concerning Me." And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.

Luke 24:46-47

- Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

1 Timothy 2:5-6

- For *there is* one God and **one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time,**

Romans 8:34

- Who *is* he who condemns? *It is* Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even **at the right hand of God**, who also **makes intercession for us**.

1 John 2:1-2

- My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, **we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous**. And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

Hebrews 7:23-25

- Also there were many priests, because they were prevented by death from continuing. But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood. Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since **He always lives to make intercession for them.**

- For *there is* not a word on my tongue, *But* behold, O LORD, **You know it altogether**



Matthew 26:30-31

- And when they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives. Then Jesus said to them, "All of you will be made to stumble because of Me this night, for it is written: 'I will strike the Shepherd, And the sheep of the flock will be scattered.'

Zechariah 13:7

- "Awake, O sword, **against My Shepherd**, Against the Man who is My Companion," Says the LORD of hosts. "**Strike the Shepherd, And the sheep will be scattered**; Then I will turn My hand against the little ones.

Matthew 27:46

- And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"

Romans 1:4

- *and* declared *to be* the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, *by the resurrection* from the dead.

- "Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake.



2 Corinthians 1:8-9

- For we do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, of **our trouble** which came to us in Asia: that we were burdened beyond measure, above strength, so that **we despaired even of life**. Yes, **we had the sentence of death in ourselves**, that we should not trust in ourselves but in God who raises the dead,

Revelation 1:9

- I, John, both your brother and companion in the tribulation and kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was on the island that is called Patmos for the word of God and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.



John 15:18-19

- " If **the world hates you**, you know that it hated Me before *it hated* you. If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because **you are not of the world**, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.

John 15:20-21

- "Remember the word that I said to you, 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, **they will also persecute you**. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also. But all these things they will do to you for My name's sake, because they do not know Him who sent Me.

John 16:2-4

- "They will **put you out of the synagogues**; yes, the time is coming that whoever **kills you** will think that he offers God service. And these things they will do to you because they have not known the Father nor Me. But these things I have told you, that when the time comes, you may remember that I told you of them. And these things I did not say to you at the beginning, because I was with you.

1 John 5:4-5

- For **whatever is born of God overcomes the world**. And this is the victory that has overcome the world -- **our faith**.
- Who is he who overcomes the world, but **he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?**
