# **A Unique Prayer**

No conditional statements.

No confession of sin.

 Requests among equals (erotáo) rather than petitions from an inferior to a superior (aitéo).

# **Sections of the Prayer**

Request with respect to Himself (vv. 1-5 or 1-8)

Request with respect to the apostles (vv. 6-19 or 9-19)

Request with respect to the universal church (vv. 20-26)

Jesus deserves to be honored by the Father (John 17:1)

#### John 12:27

Now My soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour.

# Philippians 2:7-8

but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

# Philippians 2:9-11

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

## **Psalm 2:7-8**
