

Jesus Prays for His True Disciples

John 17:6-19

A Unique Prayer

- No conditional statements.
- No confession of sin.
- Requests among equals (erotáo) rather than petitions from an inferior to a superior (aitéo).

Sections of the Prayer

- Request with respect to Himself (vv. 1-5 or 1-8)
- Request with respect to the apostles (vv. 6-19 or 9-19)
- Request with respect to the universal church (vv. 20-26)

Know Jesus and Live

- Jesus deserves to be honored by the Father (John 17:1)
- Jesus has authority over all creation (John 17:2a)
- Jesus gives eternal life (John 17:2b-3)
- Jesus seeks God's glory (John 17:4)
- Jesus possesses divine attributes (John 17:5)
- Jesus reveals God to God's people (John 17:6)
- Jesus has the power, teaching, and authority of the Father (John 17:7)
- Jesus speaks the words of the Father (John 17:8a)
- Jesus has a divine origin (John 17:8b)

Be a genuine disciple of Jesus

- Notice who those disciples are (John 17:6-11a)
- Experience the Father's care (John 17:11b-15)
- Become more like the Father and the Son (John 17:16-19)

John 15:27

- "And you also will bear witness, because you have been with Me from the beginning.
