



The Man of Sorrows Rejected by Men

John 18:13-27

[Meet the Man of Sorrows]

- He was rejected by His friends (John 18:13-18)

[John 11:49-50, 53]

- And one of them, Caiaphas, being high priest that year, said to them, "You know nothing at all, nor do you consider that it is expedient for us that one man should die for the people, and not that the whole nation should perish."
- Then, from that day on, they plotted to put Him to death.

[John 21:24]

- This is **the disciple** who testifies of these things, and wrote these things; and we know that his testimony is true.

[Peter's Denial]

- **First denial:** prompted by a slave girl
- **Second denial:** Matthew and Mark have a servant girl prompting it; Luke has another (masc.); John has “they.”
- **Third denial:** Luke has a man; Matthew and Mark “those who were standing”; John has a relative of Malcus

[Meet the Man of Sorrows]

- He was rejected by His friends (John 18:13-18)
- He was despised by men (John 18:19-27)

[Isaiah 50:5-6]

- The Lord GOD has opened My ear; And I was not rebellious, Nor did I turn away. I gave My back to those who struck Me, And My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting.

[Micah 5:1]

- Now gather yourself in troops, O daughter of troops; He has laid siege against us; **They will strike the judge of Israel with a rod on the cheek.**

[Isaiah 53:3]

- He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.
