John 19:17-30



Romans 15:4

- For whatever things were written before were written **for our learning**, that we through the **patience and comfort** of the Scriptures might have **hope**.



1 Peter 1:10-11

- Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of *the grace that would come to you*, searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.



1 Peter 10:12

- To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but **to us they were ministering** the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven -- things which angels desire to look into.



God planned to save you and He wants you to know it

- Jesus died at the place of God's choice
(John 19:17-18a)



Kinds of Offerings

- Whole burnt offerings (Leviticus 1)
- Peace (Well-being) offerings (Lev 3)
- Sin offerings (Lev 4)

- Grain offerings (Lev 2)
- Drink offerings (libation)



Leviticus 4:11-12

- 'But the bull's hide and all its flesh, with its head and legs, its entrails and offal -- the whole bull he shall carry outside the camp to a clean place, where the ashes are poured out, and burn it on wood with fire; where the ashes are poured out it shall be burned.



Leviticus 6:30

- 'But no sin offering from which *any* of the blood is brought into the tabernacle of meeting, to make atonement in the holy *place*, shall be eaten. It shall be burned in the fire.



Hebrews 13:10-12

- We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. For the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned outside the camp. Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.

Isaiah 53:10-11

- Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put *Him* to grief. When You make His soul **an offering for sin**, He shall see *His* seed, He shall prolong *His* days, And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. He shall see the labor of His soul, *and* be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For **He shall bear their iniquities**.



Isaiah 53:12

- Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.



1 Timothy 1:15

- This *is* a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief.

Zechariah 9:9

- " Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!
Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem!
Behold, *your King is coming to you*; He
is just and having salvation, Lowly and
riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a
donkey.

- To the Chief Musician. Set to "The Deer of the Dawn." A Psalm of David. *My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? Why are You so far from helping Me, And from the words of My groaning?*



Psalm 22:18

- They divide My garments among them,
And for My clothing they cast lots.



Psalm 22:15

- My strength is dried up like a potsherd,
And My tongue clings to My jaws; You
have brought Me to the dust of death.
