John 3:31-36

# Psalm 7:11-13

---

- God *is* a just judge, And **God is angry with the wicked every day**. If he does not turn back, He will **sharpen His sword**; He **bends His bow** and makes it ready. He also prepares for Himself **instruments of death**; He **makes His arrows into fiery shafts**.

# Psalm 5:5-6

---

- The boastful shall not stand in Your sight; You hate all workers of iniquity. You shall destroy those who speak falsehood; The LORD abhors the bloodthirsty and deceitful man.

# Luke 3:21-22

---

- When all the people were baptized, it came to pass that Jesus also was baptized; and while He prayed, the heaven was opened. And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and **a voice came from heaven** which said, "**You are My beloved Son**; in You I am well pleased."

# John 3:11-13

---

- "Most assuredly, I say to you, We speak what We know and testify what We have seen, and you do not receive Our witness. If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, **how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things?** No one has ascended to heaven but **He who came down from heaven, *that is, the Son of Man*** who is in heaven.

# John 1:11-12

---

- He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:



# 1 John 5:9-11

---

- If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater; for this is the witness of God which He has testified of His Son. He who believes in the Son of God has the witness in himself; **he who does not believe God has made Him a liar**, because he has not believed the testimony that God has given of His Son. And this is the testimony: that **God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son.**

# John 12:49-50

---

- "For I have not spoken on My own *authority*; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak. And I know that His command is everlasting life. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak."

# Hebrews 1:1-2

---

- **God**, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, **has in these last days spoken to us by *His Son***, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;

# Luke 3:21-22

---

# Matthew 28:18

---

- And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

# Jesus is superior in authority to all

---

- **Colossians 1:19** For it pleased *the Father that* in Him **all the fullness should dwell,**
- **Hebrews 1:9** You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; Therefore God, Your God, **has anointed You With the oil of gladness more than Your companions."**

# Hebrews 1:5, 13

---

- For to which of the angels did He ever say: "You are My Son, Today I have begotten You"? And again: "I will be to Him a Father, And He shall be to Me a Son"?
- But to which of the angels has He ever said: "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"?



# John 17:5

---

- "And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

# John 17:2

---

- "as You have given Him **authority over all flesh**, that He should **give eternal life** to as many as You have given Him.

# Don't dismiss the Son of God:

- Rely on Him (John 3:36)

# John 5:24

---

- " Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me **has** everlasting life, and **shall not come into judgment**, but **has passed** from death into life.

# John 3:3

---

- Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he **cannot see** the kingdom of God."

# John 16:8-9

---

- "And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: **of sin, because they do not believe in Me;**

# The Testimony of John the Baptist

---

- **John 1:29b** "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"
- **John 1:34** "And I have seen and testified that this is the Son of God."
- **John 3:36** "He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."
