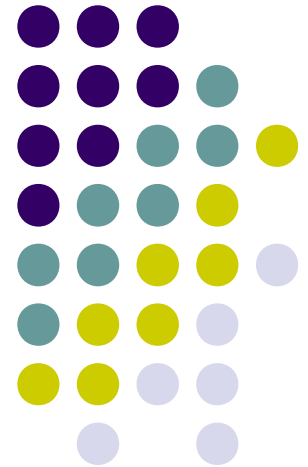


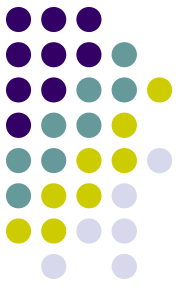

# Conversation with the Samaritan Woman



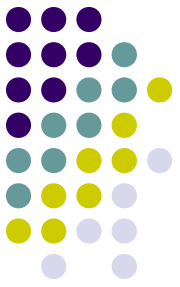
- The message of salvation is for all peoples
- Salvation is a gift of God
- Jesus is greater than Jacob because
  - The water He provides satisfies and keeps alive forever
  - He has divine knowledge and divine holiness
- Genuine believers show their devotion to the Father

# Conversation with the Samaritan Woman (cont.)

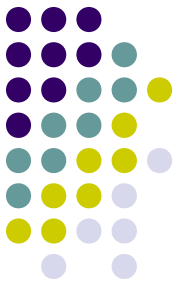


- Salvation comes from the Jews
- God, as a spiritual being, is not tied to any particular location
- God must be worshipped
  - with the right attitude
  - according to the truth He has revealed
- Jesus is the Christ

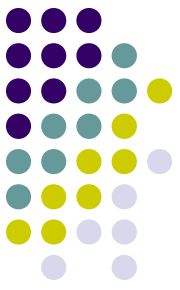

# Galatians 3:27-28

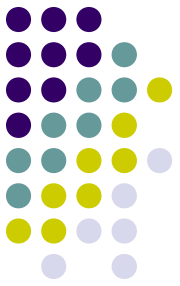

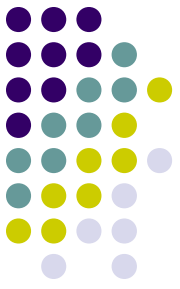
# 1 Peter 3:7

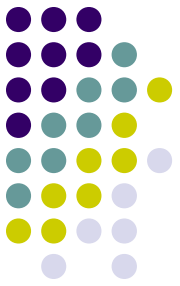


# Amos 9:13

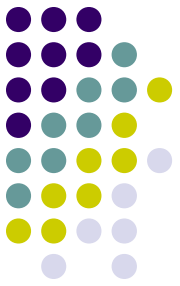
# Be involved in the work of the Gospel

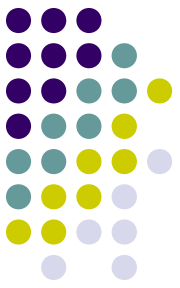


- It incorporates women (John 4:27-30)

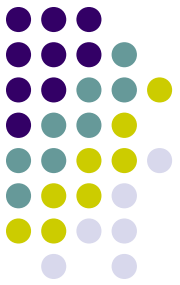
- "I sent you to reap ...





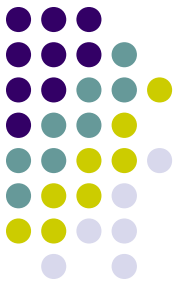
# Matthew 28:18-20

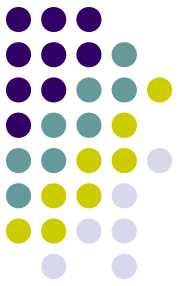
## Luke 10:2
