Examine your own faith:

Various “Faiths” found in Galilee

- The reason why Jesus went to Galilee (John 4:43-44)

John 4:1-3

- **John 4:1-3** Therefore, when the Lord knew that the Pharisees had heard that Jesus made and baptized more disciples than John (though Jesus Himself did not baptize, but His disciples), He left Judea and departed again to Galilee.

Various “Faiths” found in Galilee

- The reason why Jesus went to Galilee (John 4:43-44)
- The faith of the Galileans (John 4:45)

The Faith of the Galileans

- **John 6:41** The Jews then complained about Him, because He said, "I am the bread which came down from heaven."
- **John 6:66** From that time many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more.
- **John 7:5** For even His brothers did not believe in Him.

Various “Faiths” found in Galilee

- The reason why Jesus went to Galilee (John 4:43-44)
- The faith of the Galileans (John 4:45)
- The faith of the royal officer (John 4:46-54)
 - A faith that believes He has (limited) power (John 4:46-49)
 - A faith that believes His word (John 4:50)
 - A faith that recognizes His identity and status (John 4:51-54)

Examine your own faith:
