# Exodus 31:14-15

- 'You shall keep the Sabbath, therefore, for *it is* holy to you. Everyone who profanes it shall surely be **put to death**; for whoever does *any* work on it, that person shall be cut off from among his people. 'Work shall be done for six days, but the seventh *is* the Sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD. **Whoever does *any* work** on the Sabbath day, he shall **surely be put to death**.

# Exodus 35:2-3

- "Work shall be done for six days, but the seventh day shall be a holy day for you, a Sabbath of rest to the LORD. Whoever does any work on it shall be **put to death**. You shall **kindle no fire** throughout your dwellings on the Sabbath day."

# Exodus 20:9-11

- Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day *is* the Sabbath of the LORD your God. *In it* you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who *is* within your gates. For *in* six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that *is* in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it.

# Jeremiah 17:21-22

- 'Thus says the LORD: "Take heed to yourselves, and bear no burden on the Sabbath day, nor bring *it* in by the gates of Jerusalem; nor carry a burden out of your houses on the Sabbath day, nor do any work, but hallow the Sabbath day, as I commanded your fathers.

# Jeremiah 17:27

- "But if you will not heed Me to hallow the Sabbath day, such as not carrying a burden when entering the gates of Jerusalem on the Sabbath day, then I will kindle a fire in its gates, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall not be quenched." ' "

# Nehemiah 13:15

- In those days I saw *people* in Judah treading wine presses on the Sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and loading donkeys with wine, grapes, figs, and all kinds of burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the Sabbath day. And I warned *them* about the day on which they were selling provisions.

# Nehemiah 13:19

- So it was, at the gates of Jerusalem, as it began to be dark before the Sabbath, that I commanded the gates to be shut, and charged that they must not be opened till after the Sabbath. Then I posted *some of my servants at the gates*, so *that* no burdens would be brought in on the Sabbath day.

# John 9:1-3

- Now as *Jesus* passed by, He saw a man who was blind from birth. And His disciples asked Him, saying, "Rabbi, **who sinned**, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?"
- Jesus answered, "**Neither this man nor his parents sinned**, but that the works of God should be revealed in him.

# Matthew 10:28

- "And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

# Romans 2:3-4

- And do you think this, O man, you who judge those practicing such things, and doing the same, that you will escape the judgment of God? Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?

# Romans 2:5-6

- But in accordance with **your hardness** and **your impenitent heart** you are **treasuring up for yourself wrath** in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, who "will render to each one according to his deeds":



# Romans 2:7-9

- eternal life to those who by patient continuance in doing good seek for glory, honor, and immortality; but to those who are self-seeking and **do not obey the truth**, but obey unrighteousness -- **indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish**, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek;
