

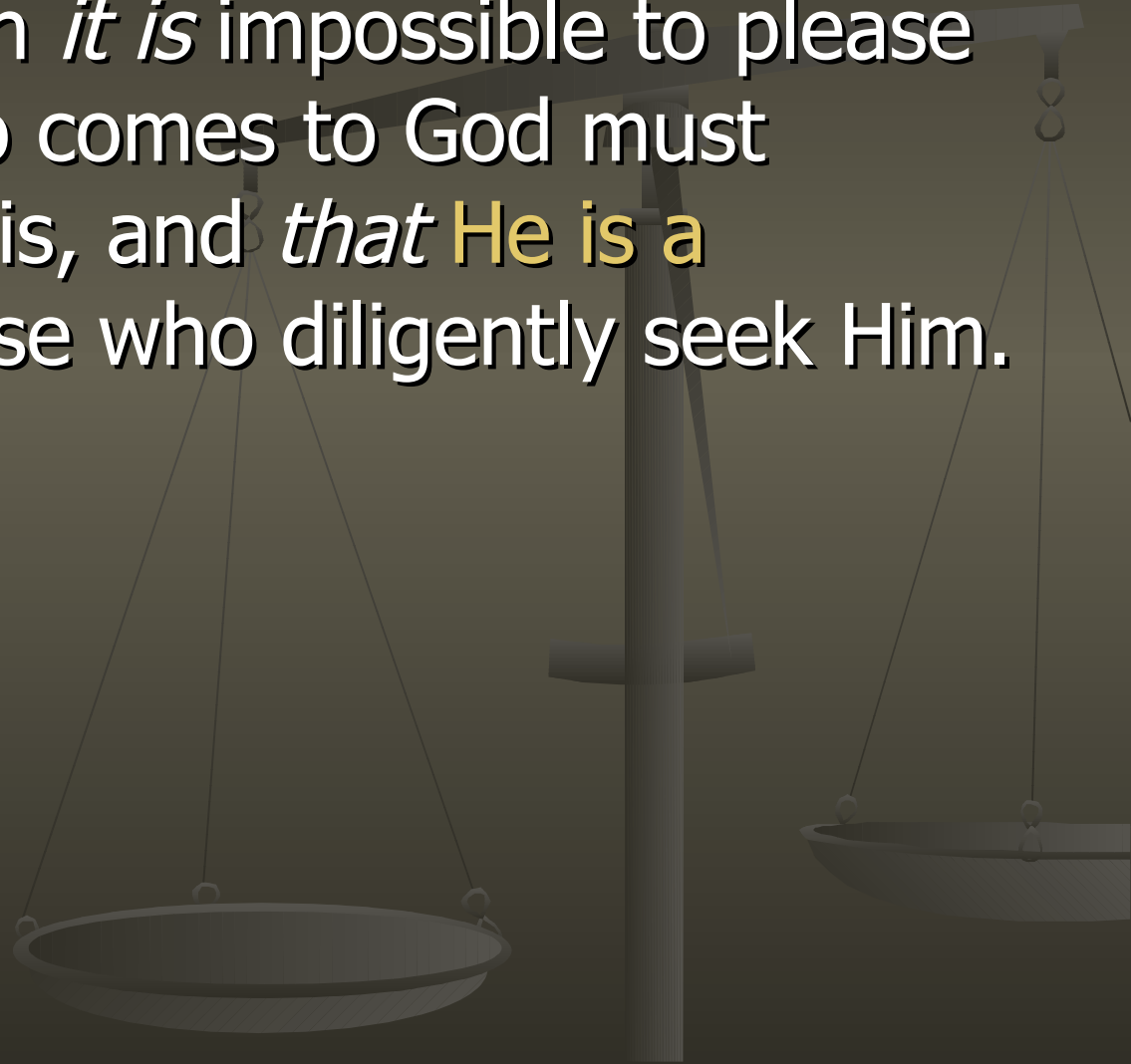


A Warning against Abuse of Power

Hebrews 11:6

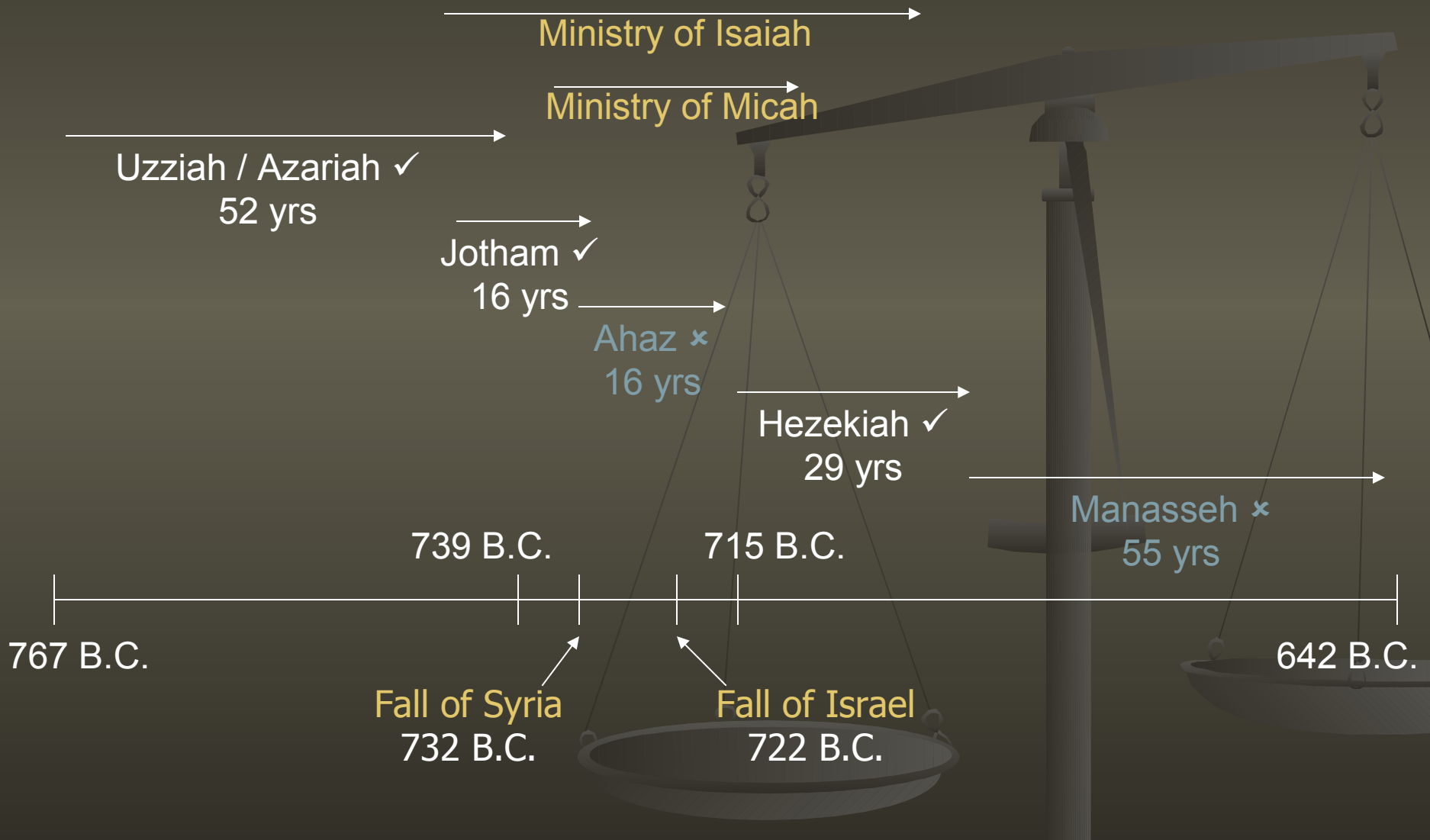
- But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that He is a rewarder* of those who diligently seek Him.



Hebrews 11:24-26

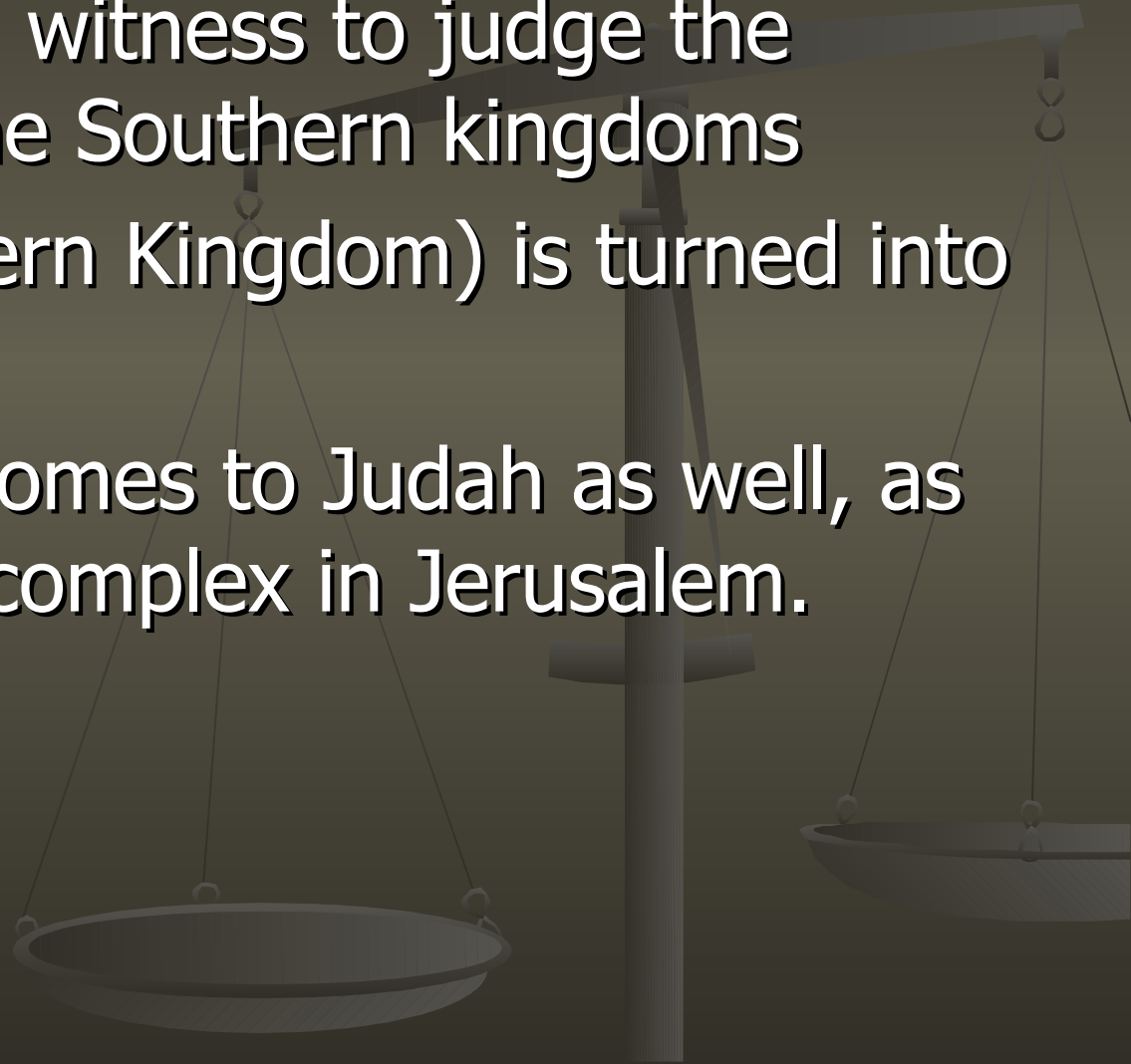

Micah 1

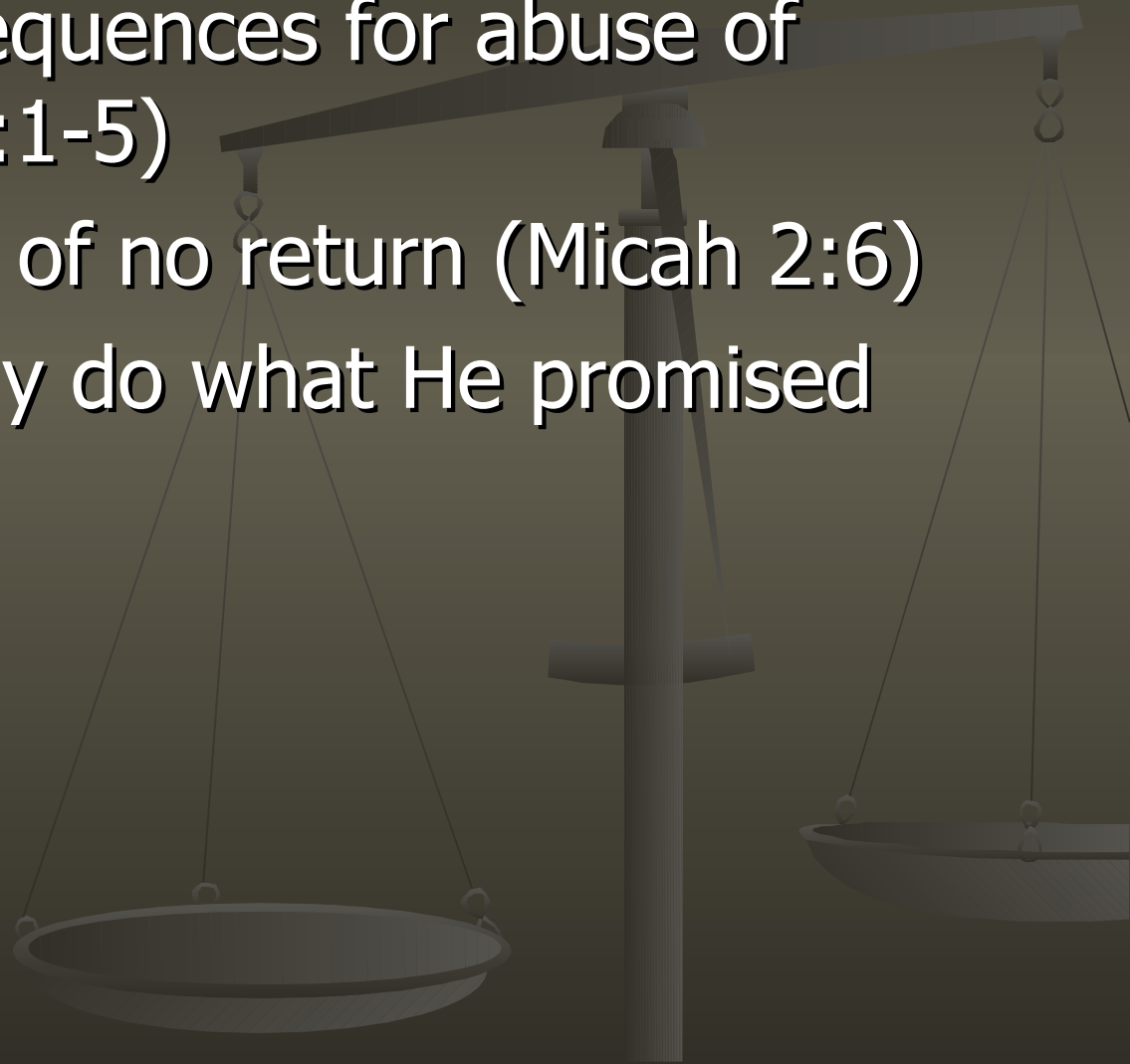
- God comes as a witness to judge the Northern and the Southern kingdoms
- Samaria (Northern Kingdom) is turned into a heap of ruins
- The judgment comes to Judah as well, as far as the gate complex in Jerusalem.



Act in Wisdom

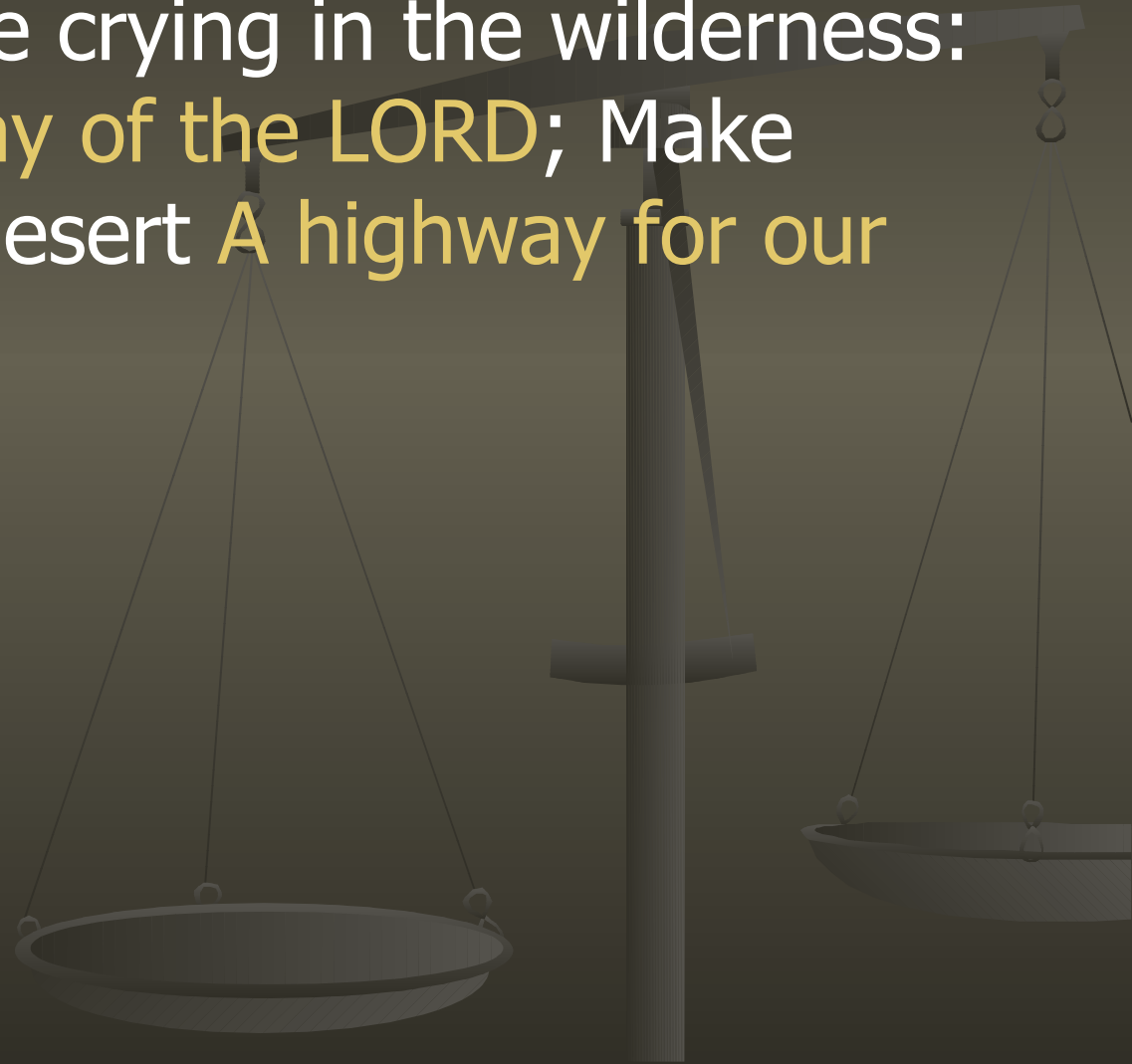
Keep Trusting in God's ways

- God will certainly do what He promised (Micah 2:7-13)



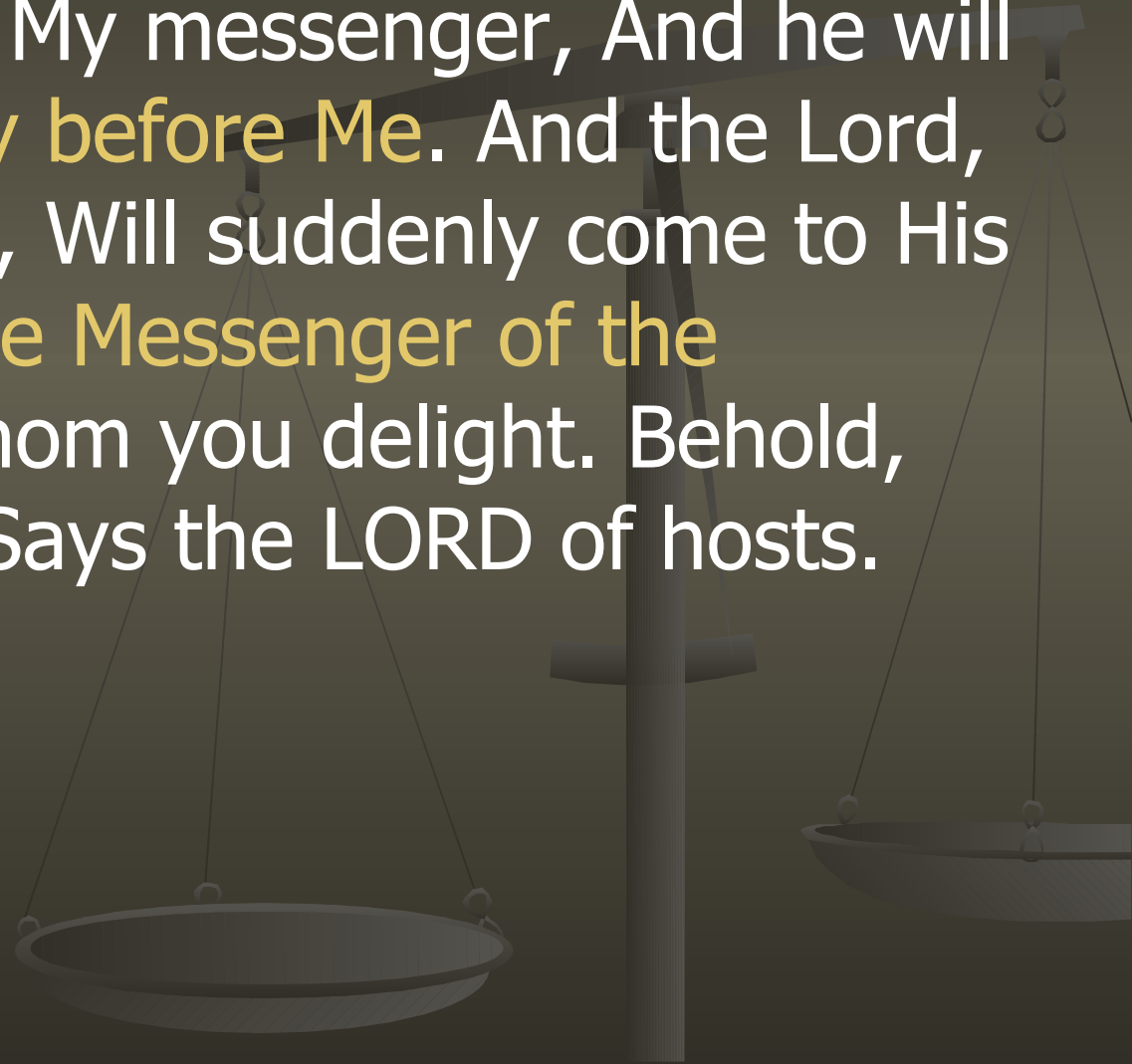
Isaiah 40:3

God.**



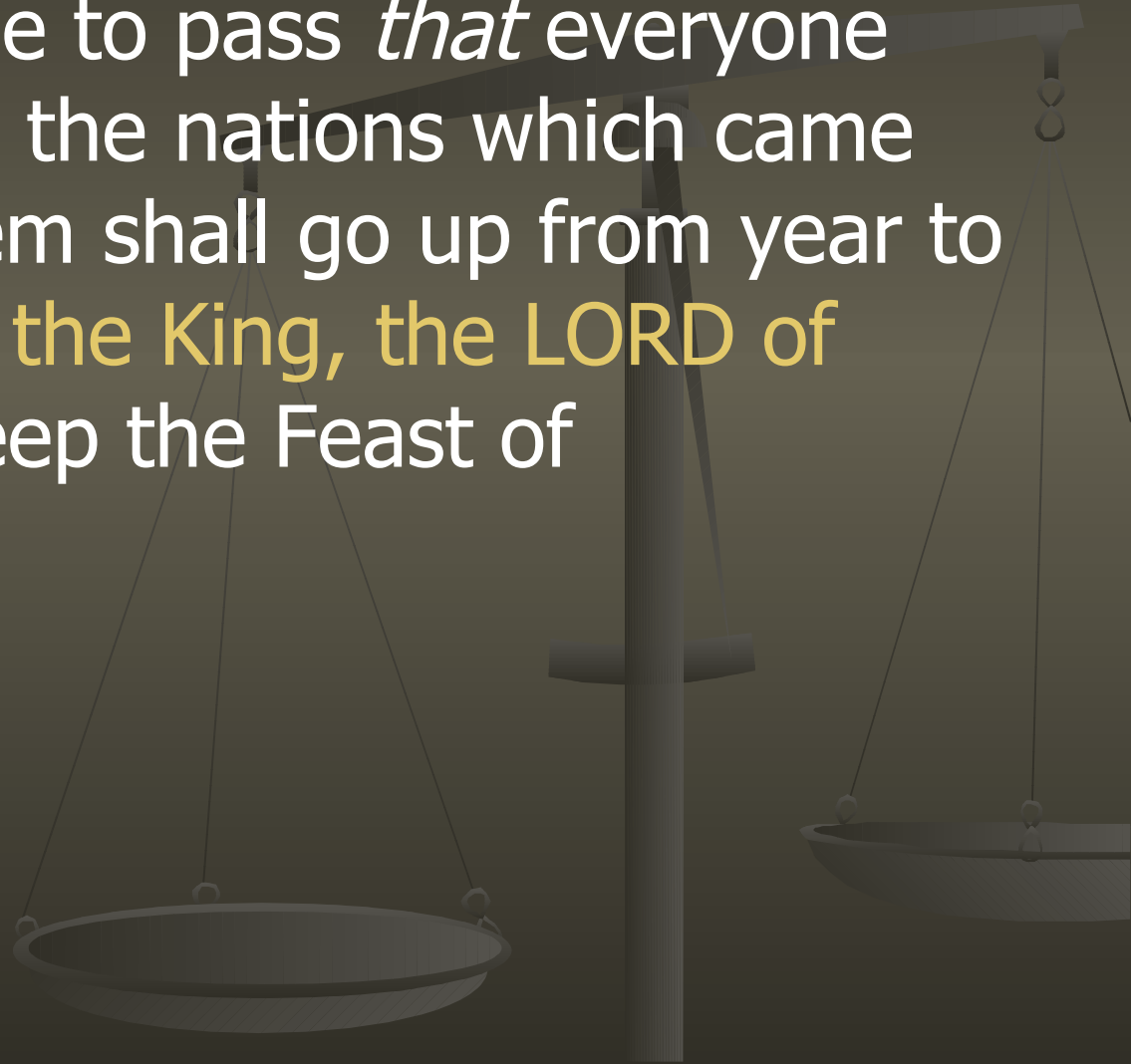
Malachi 3:1

- And it shall come to pass *that* everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year **to worship the King, the LORD of hosts,** and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.
