

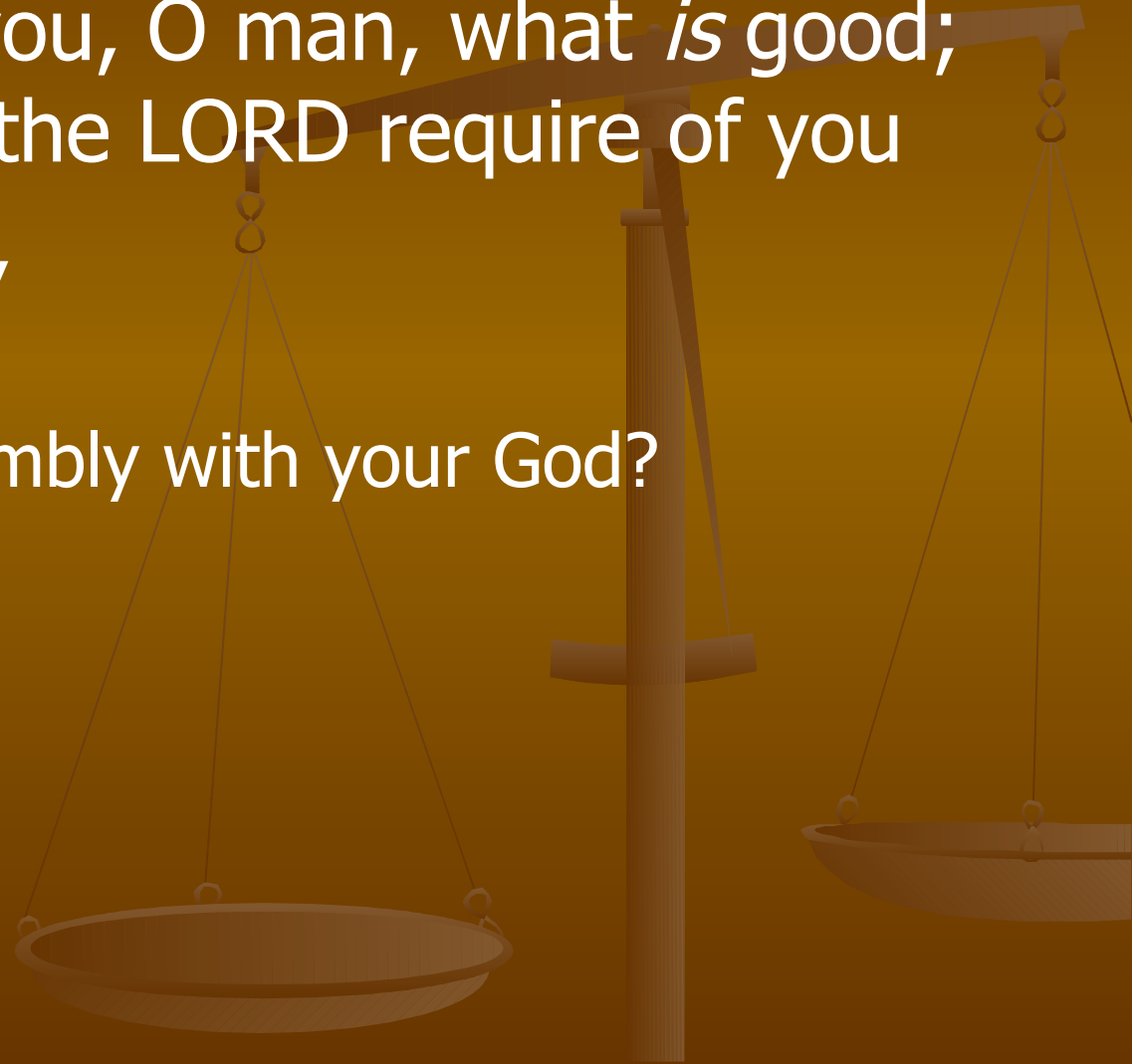
God's Judgment for the Unconcerned City

 - And to walk humbly with your God?



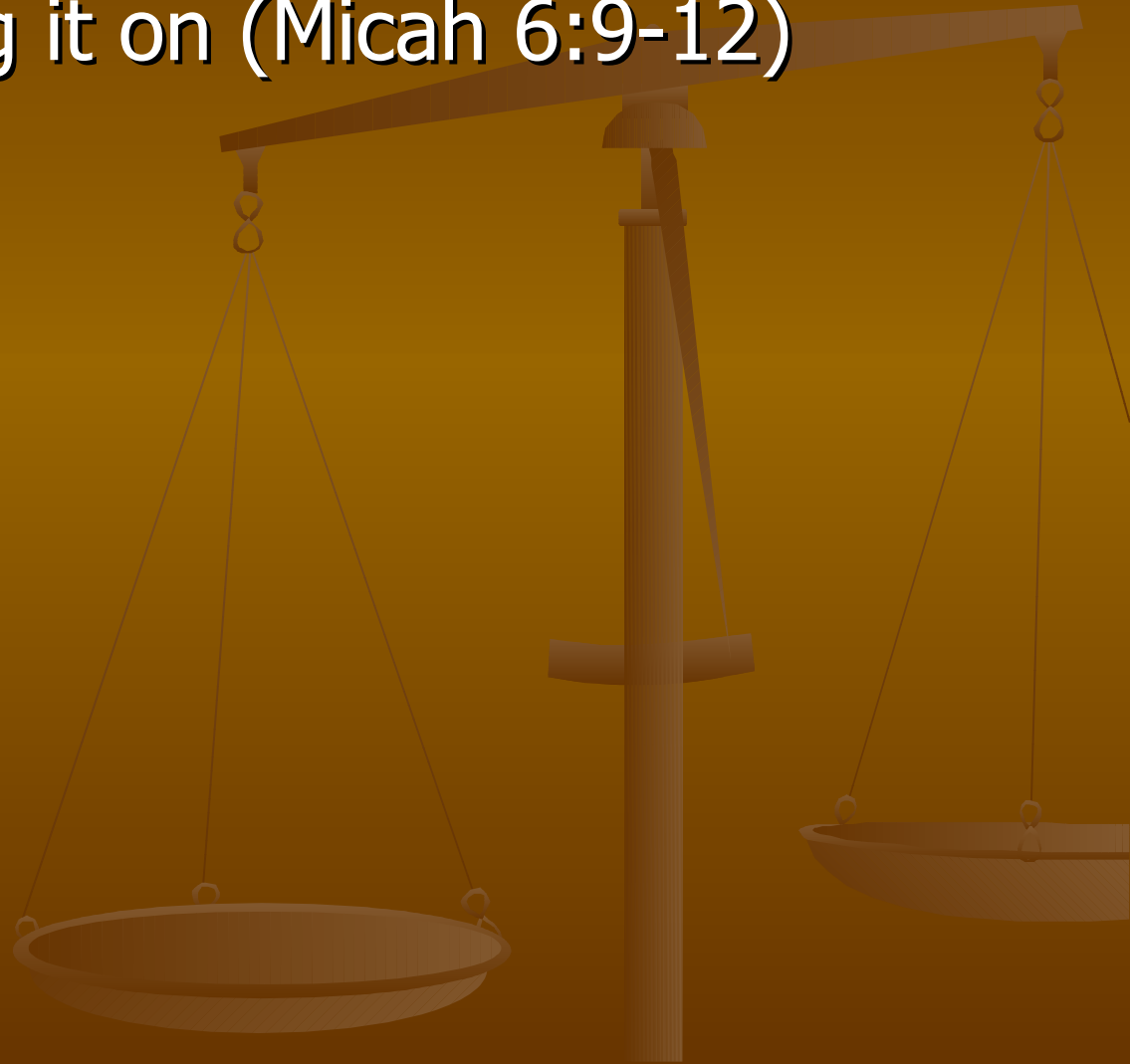

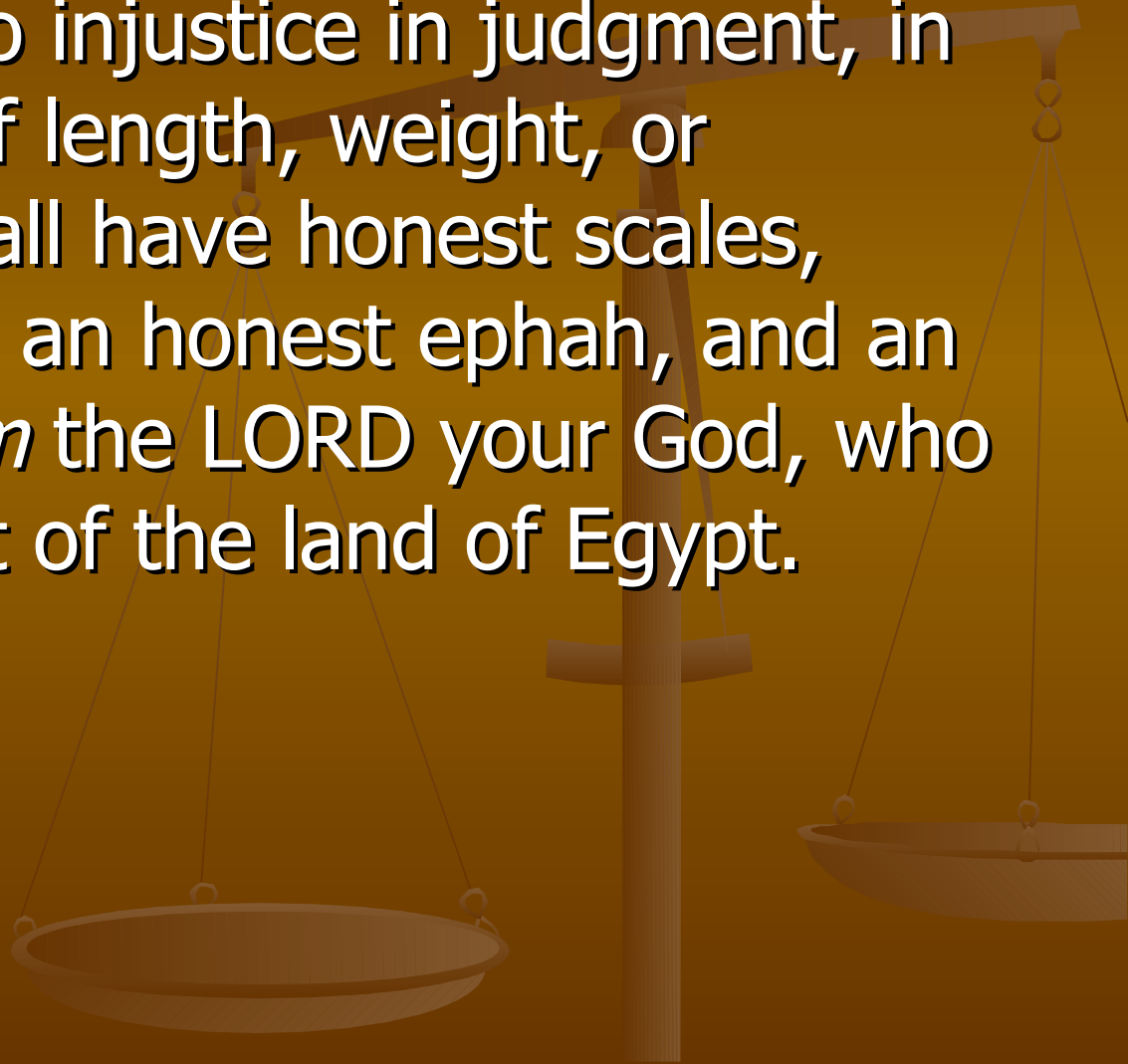

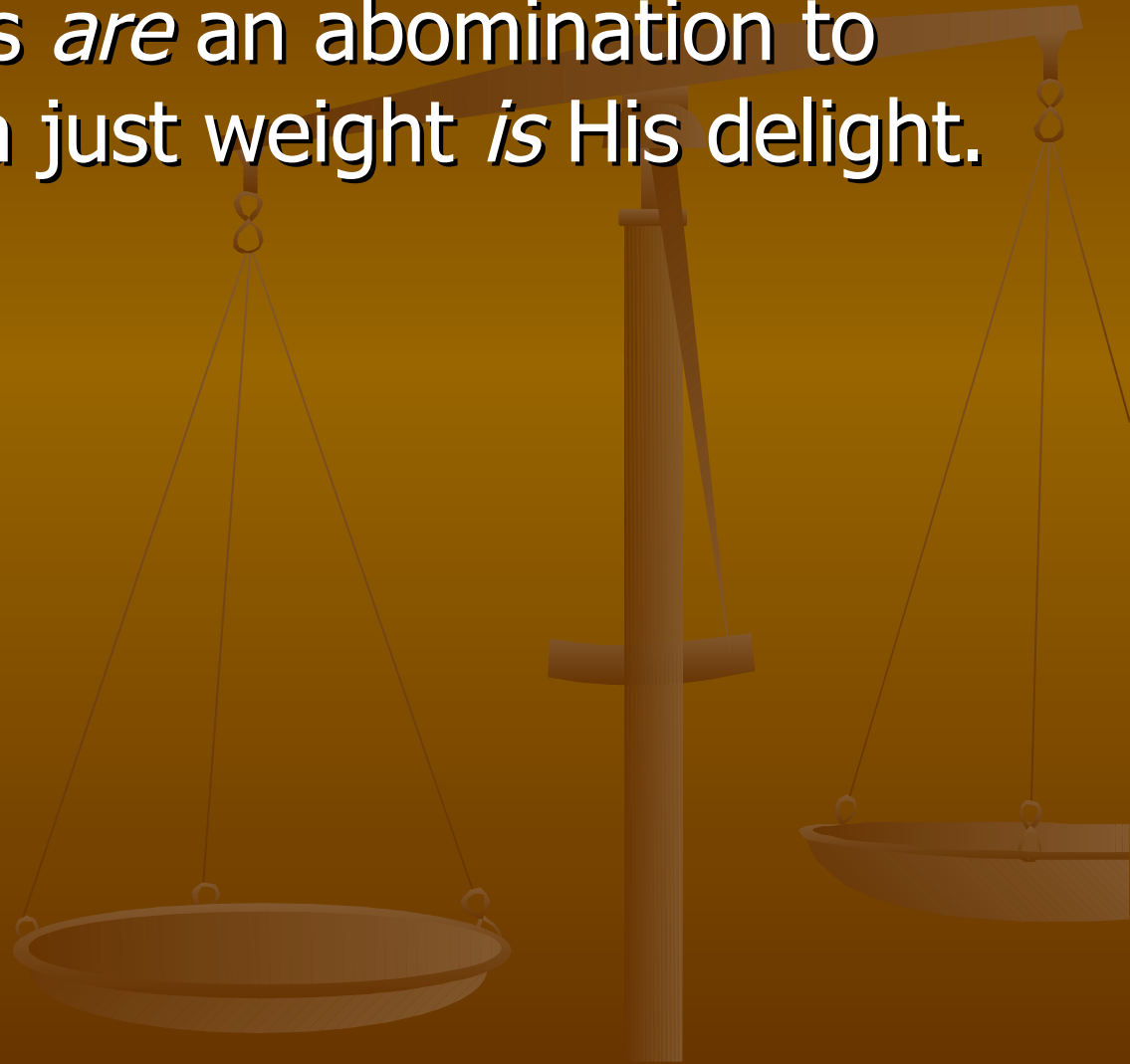
Leviticus 19:35-36

- ' You shall do no injustice in judgment, in measurement of length, weight, or volume. You shall have honest scales, honest weights, an honest ephah, and an honest hin: I *am* the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt.



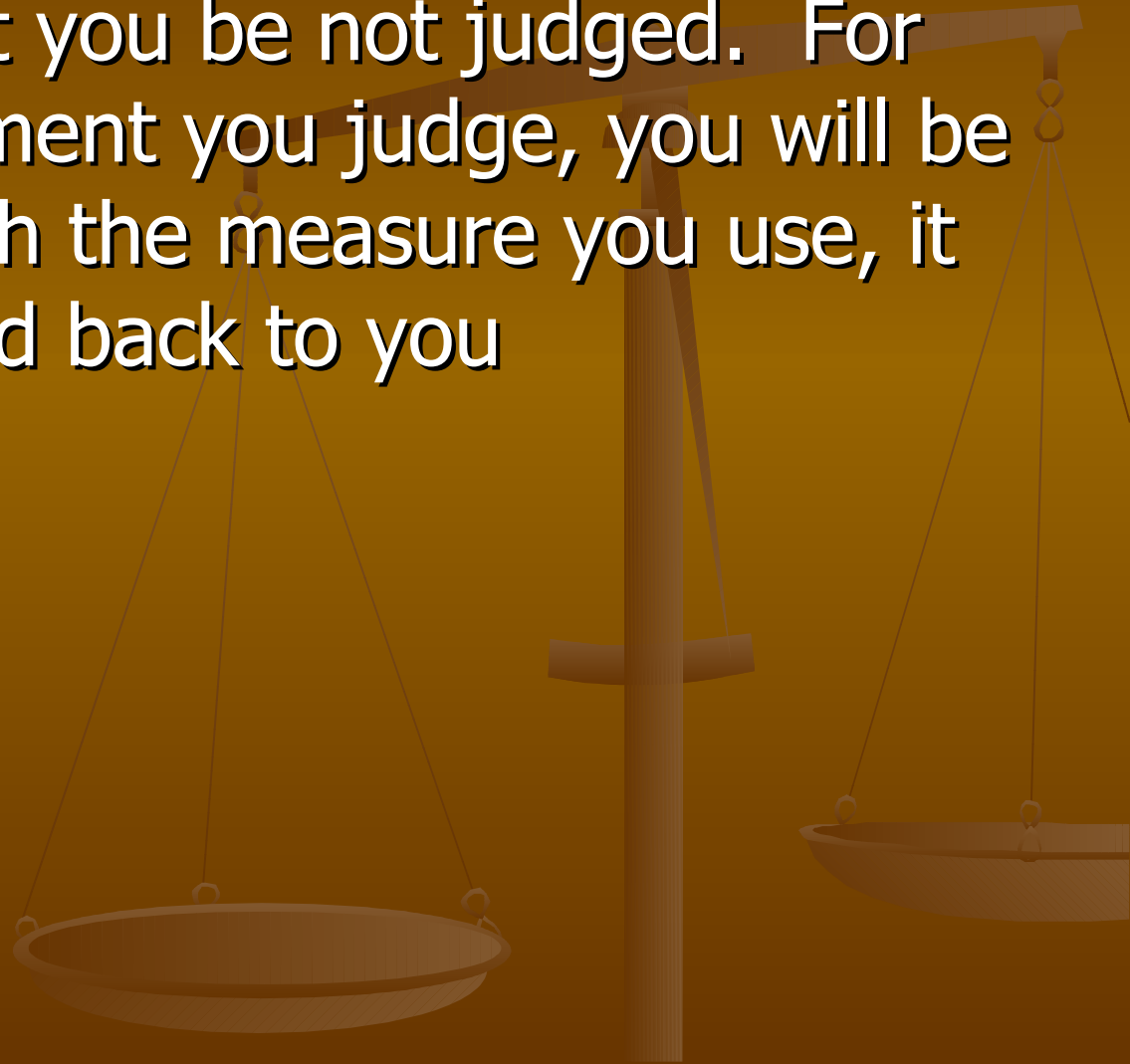
Proverbs 11:1

- Dishonest scales *are* an abomination to the LORD, But a just weight *is* His delight.




Matthew 7:1-2

- "Judge not, that you be not judged. For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you



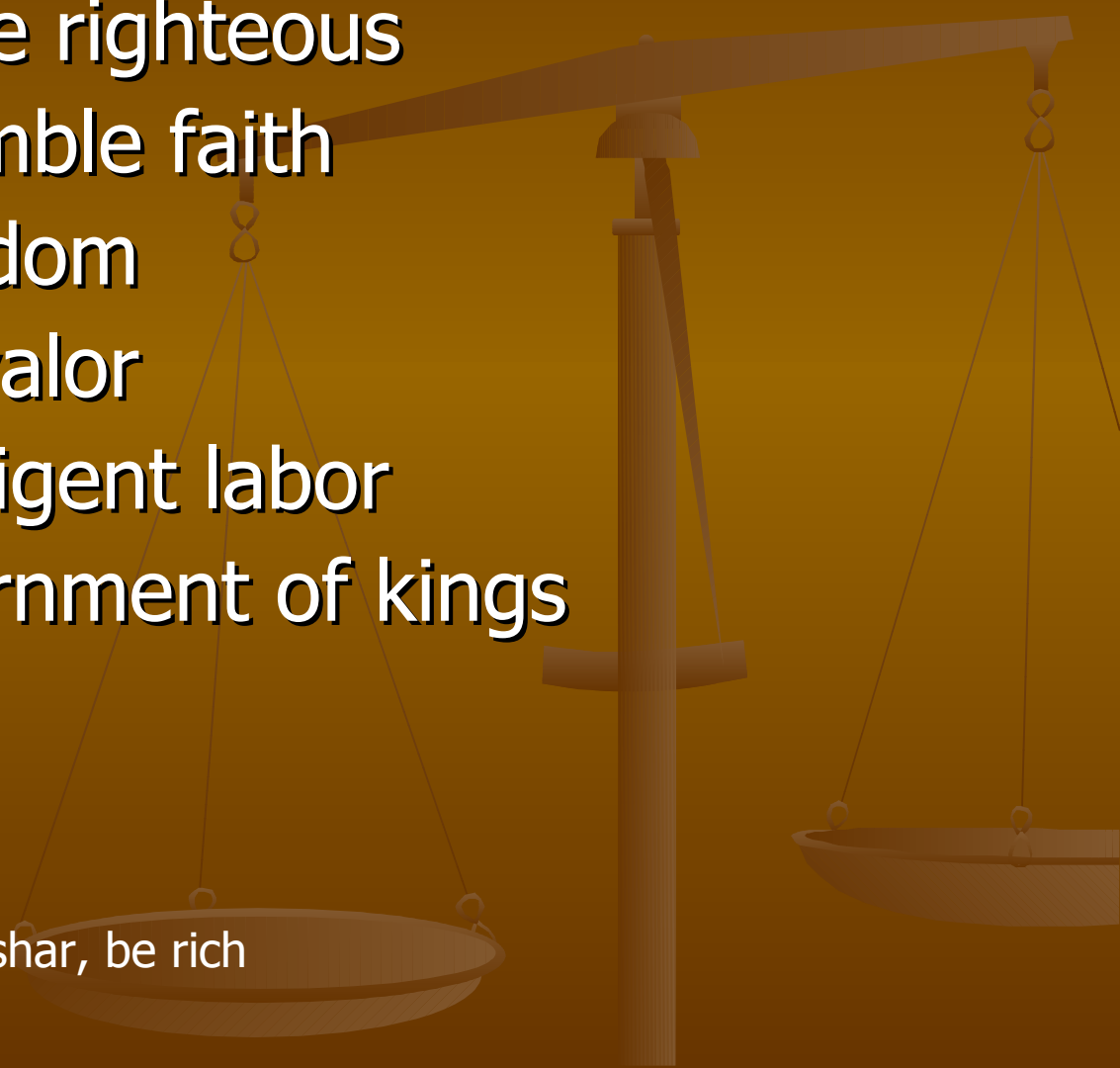
Treasure in Proverbs

- **Proverbs 10:2** Treasures of wickedness profit nothing, But righteousness delivers from death.
 - **Proverbs 15:16** Better *is* a little with the fear of the LORD, Than great treasure with trouble.
 - **Proverbs 21:6** Getting treasures by a lying tongue *Is* the fleeting fantasy of those who seek death.

Riches can be...

- A blessing to the righteous
- A reward of humble faith
- The gain of wisdom
- The reward of valor
- The result of diligent labor
- The proper adornment of kings

Summarized from TWOT, ashar, be rich



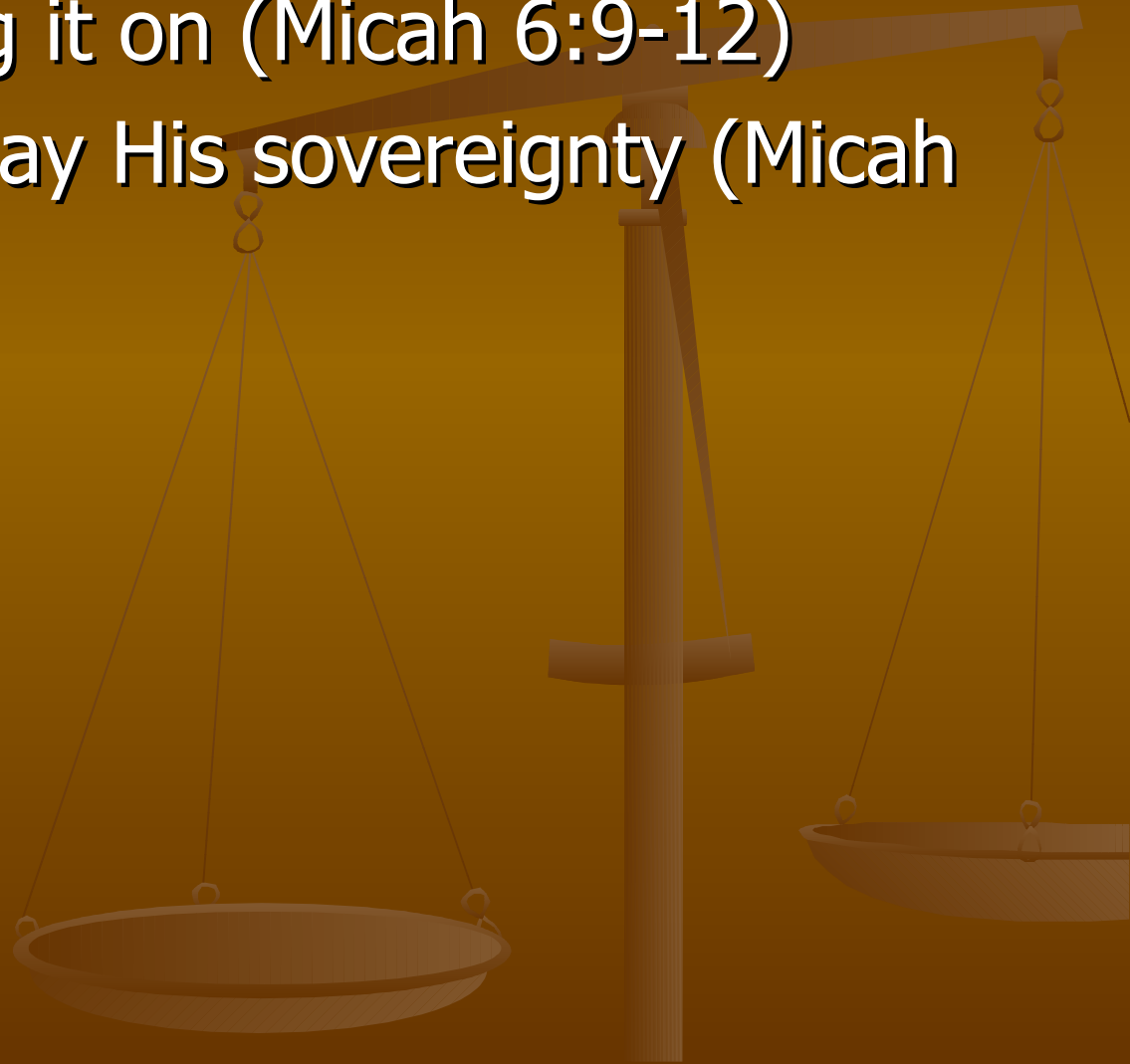
On the other hand, riches...

- Can lead to self-dependence rather than dependence on YHWH
- Can be a source of pride (knowing YHWH is a better thing to boast about)
- Fly away
- Bring judgment if derived from deceit and treachery
- Cannot redeem a soul
- Don't and cannot last (a good name is more desirable)

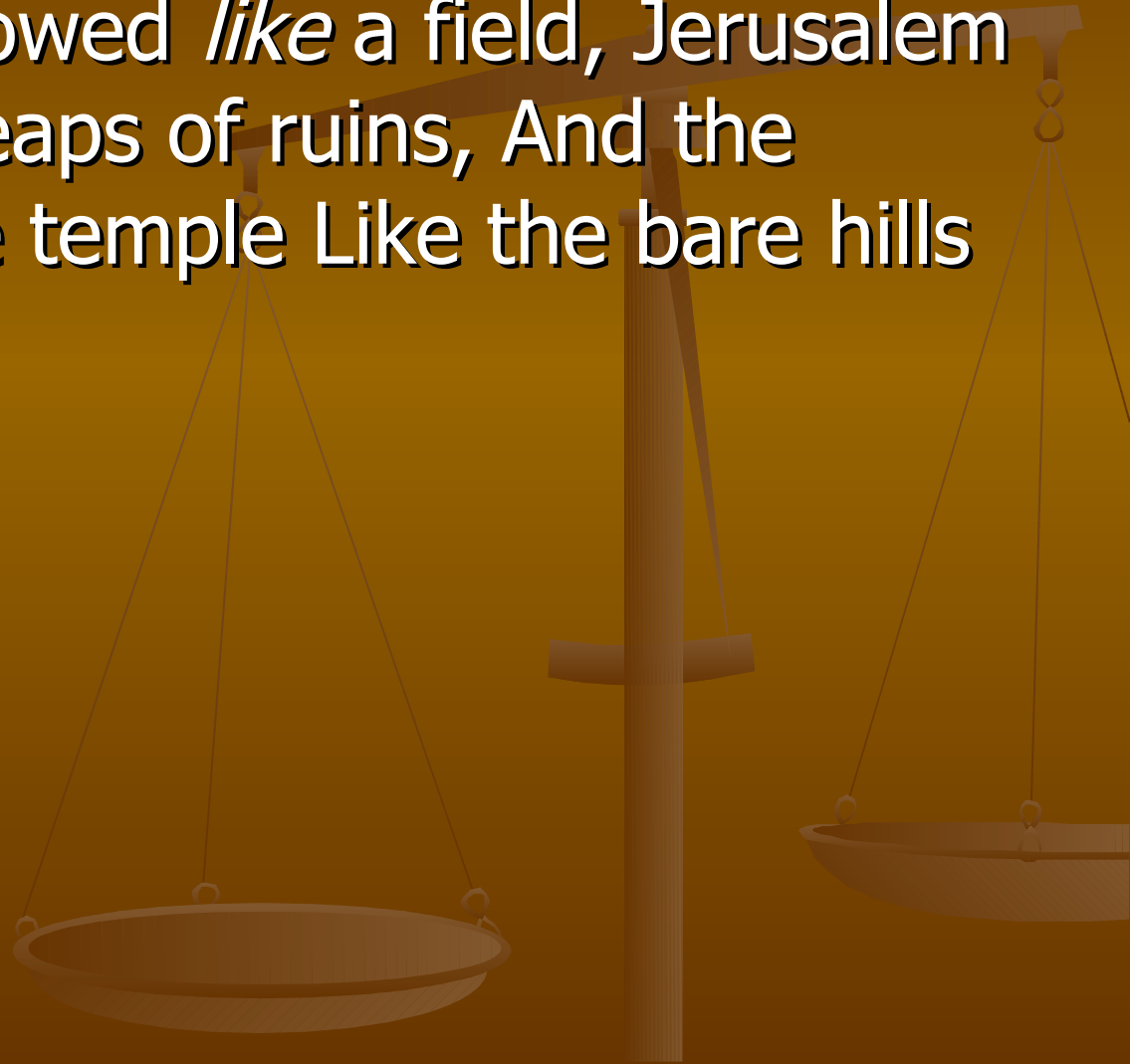

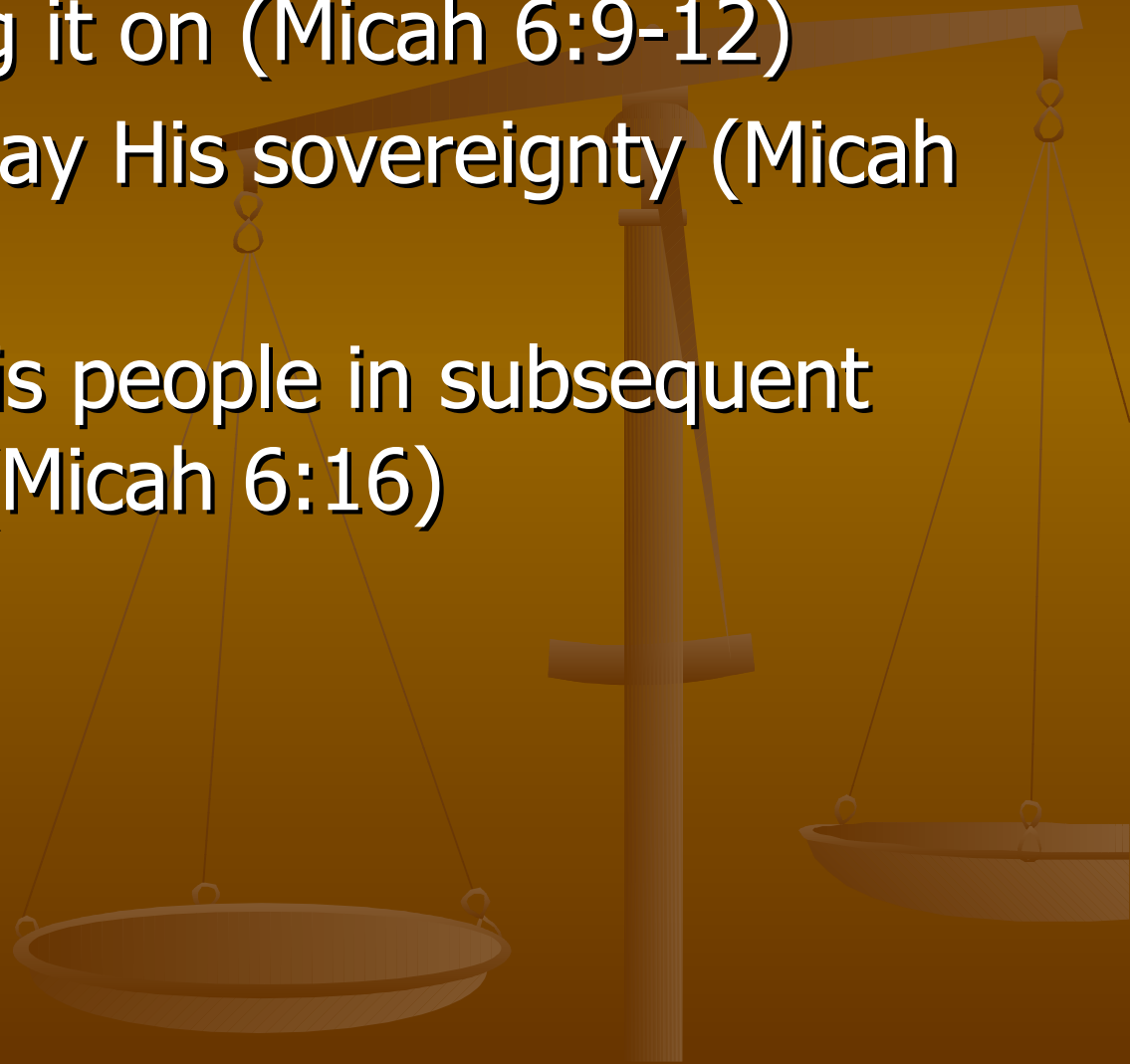
Micah 3:12b

- Zion shall be plowed *like* a field, Jerusalem shall become heaps of ruins, And the mountain of the temple Like the bare hills of the forest.




Listen to God's Judgment for the unconcerned city

- God warns His people in subsequent generations (Micah 6:16)

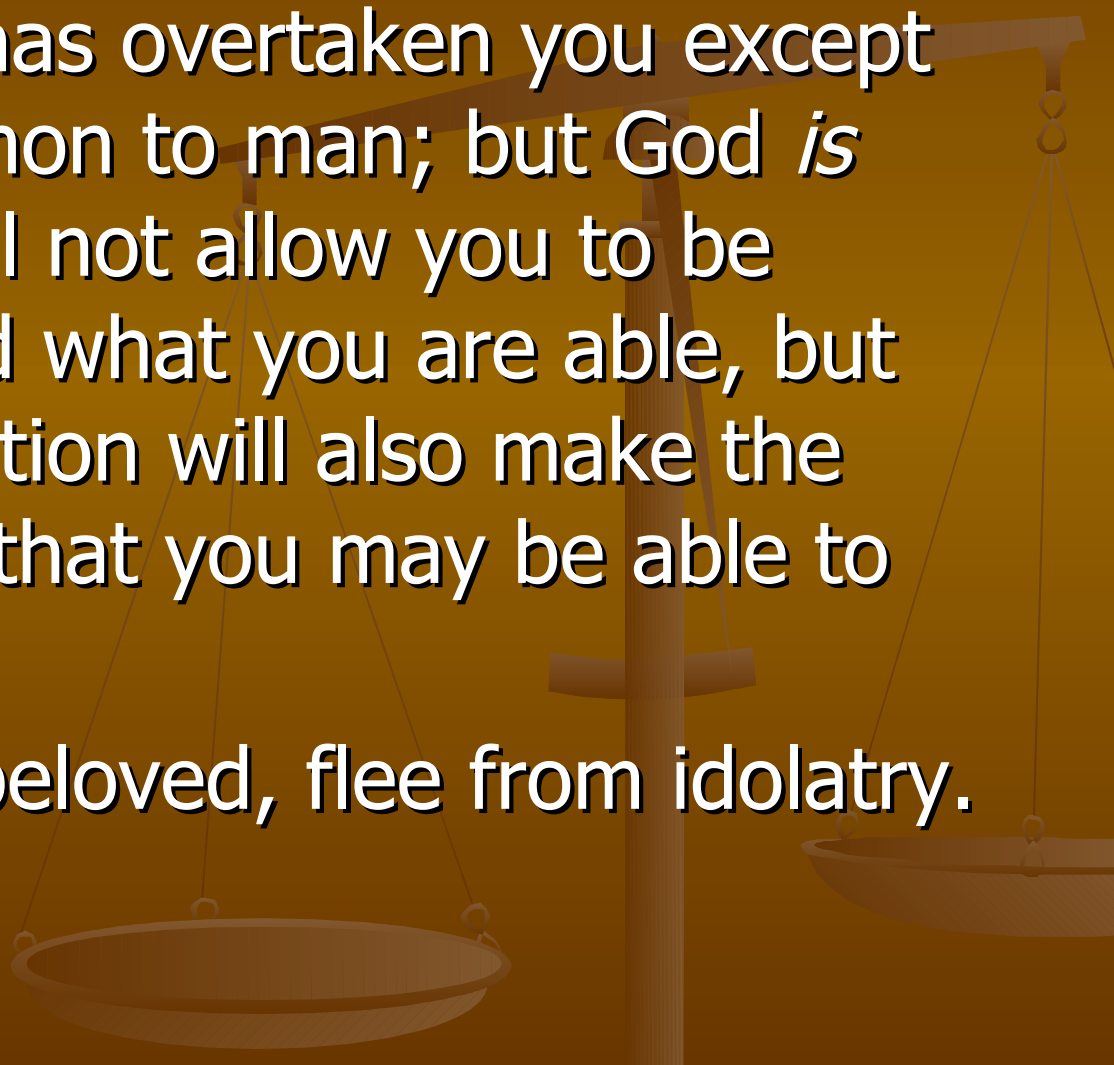


1 Corinthians 10:11-12

- No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*.
